'Midsummer Nights Dream' Open Air Theatre:

Maidenhead Drama Guild are performing this classic Shakespeare play in the open air within the grounds of Berkshire College of Agriculture, Burchetts Green, on Tuesday 22nd July. The performance begins at 7.45pm although the grounds will be open from 6pm if you wish to bring a picnic. Alternatively you can book a pre-theatre buffet supper which will be served in the main building, Hall Place mansion, which is a beautiful listed building. The great advantage of this open air performance is that it will go ahead whatever the weather, as it will be transferred to one of the lecture theatres if it is inclement. Tickets cost £11 for adults and £9 concessions; buffet supper is £13.50 per head. Judging by last year's experience, the supper tickets sell out very quickly.
