

St. Luke's Daylight Group

This is a group which has only recently started to meet on a slightly more formal basis. It originated when a group of our congregation who took the Bible Reading Fellowship New Daylight Notes regularly decided to meet in the home of Pat Brooks, to discuss the Bible passages and the notes on them. The group now meets at the home of Jan and Dick Cheek, (26, Sheephouse Road, Maidenhead.). We meet once a month, usually the first Monday at 8.00pm. Starting with a coffee and a general chat, we then open with prayers and then address ourselves to the last month's readings. The biblical passages and their commentaries usually follow a theme for two or three weeks, and often provide a space for a festival or "special day". Themes we have followed recently, include, "Change: the sign of life"; "The mystery of suffering"; "The worst of sinners" and "Seasons of Thanksgiving": We also managed to study a series of readings entitled "Christmas with Luke, along with some advent passages. We have all found the BRF notes very helpful and would recommend them for private use, even if you are unable to join us in our group discussion. The BRF notes can be purchased from Don Luff, who is in church most Sundays. It is refreshing to hear how our friends relate to the Bible as they bring their wide variety of experience of life to our discussions. One thing that did emerge from our talks was that we would have a small collection at our meetings, which would go to the charity, "Sight Savers," to remind ourselves that the Bible is not just for use as a talking shop but is an inspiration for action.
