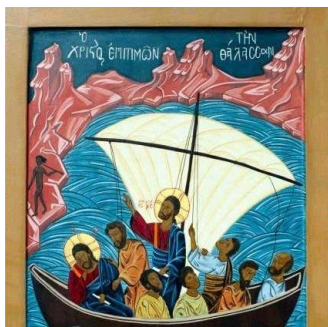

**Third Sunday of Trinity, Parish Communion**

We have bought a stole for Phyl, which we will bless this Sunday. If anyone would like to contribute would you please give your contribution to one of the churchwardens. Many thanks.

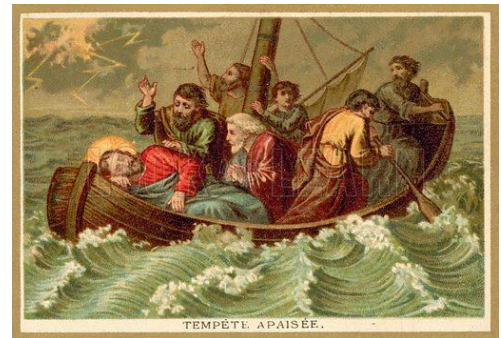
### Thought for the week:
