Week commencing: 23rd January 2022 Third Sunday of Epiphany, Parish Communion

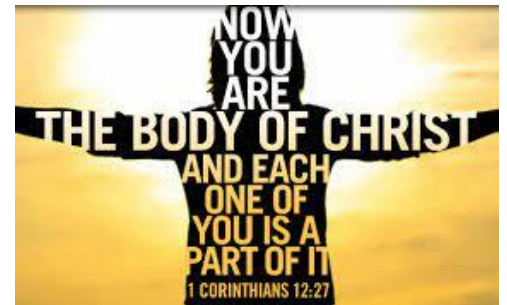
Our service this Sunday will be a Parish Communion service in church at 10 am, also on zoom.

Next week we will be keeping the Feast of the Presentation of Christ in the Temple (Candlemas). Our 10 am service will be an **All Age Christingle** service to which all are warmly invited to receive a Christingle. There will be a retiring collection for the work of the Children's Society. As this is a Word service, there will be a service of **Holy Communion at 8.00 am** next week so that those who wish to receive communion can do so (even if it means getting up a bit earlier!).

Morning Prayer continues: Tuesday – Saturday on Zoom, at 8.30 am (9 am on Sat.)

Evening Prayer, on Fridays at 5pm also on zoom, except on the first Friday monthly. We are using the Epiphany order of service – on the app or the CofE website. From 2nd February we move to the daily orders.

Thought for the week: we are currently in the middle of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. It is good to have an annual occasion to reflect on the wide variety and diversity within the whole church – world wide, nation wide and across our town. There are lots of churches across our borough – we may feel very comfortable worshiping in some, less so in others (though it could be argued that we should not be so comfortable in our worship that it becomes cosy!). We may feel more at ease or at one with the specific beliefs and practices of some of our Christian sisters and brothers, than with others. That is part of the beauty of the church – whilst maintaining a shared faith in Jesus, the Son of God, there are a rich variety of expressions of that faith. St. Paul recognised that, even not long after Jesus ceased to walk the earth physically. In his letters to the Christians in Corinth he is very clear that the variety is essential to the thriving of the whole church – the body of Christ on earth. How do we value our fellow Christians ?
