Thought for the week:

The national church takes climate change very seriously and we are all encouraged to adopt lifestyles which reflect a more responsible approach to our whole planet. The Anglican church is also encouraging us to September as the 'Season of creation', holding as it does for many Harvest thanksgivings and a focus on creation. As the world prepares for the United Nations COP26 conference in Glasgow at the start of November, it is important for all of us to reflect on our own attitude to creation and natural resources – are we stewards or consumers?



We are seeing the impact of climate change in small ways in our everyday lives and the current severe flooding in the USA caused by Storm Ida is further proof of the devastating effect it can have. This Sunday we will celebrate creation and just begin to think about little changes that we might each make to bring about the changes needed to reverse climate change and preserve God's amazing creation for all to enjoy.
